Participation of the Water Board of Lemesos (WBL) in the "Waterverse" EU programme

A group of WBL representatives participated in the opening meeting of the "Waterverse" European Programme (Horizon 2020 - Innovation Action), which took place in Thessaloniki, Greece. The Programme deals with the development of a Water Data Management Ecosystem (WDME), which aims at securing more efficient data management in water networks.

Seventeen European organisations participate in this Project, which has a total budget of approximately €5 million. The role of the WBL, in collaboration with all other participating institutions, is to apply, on a pilot basis, the various data management tools that will be developed.

The Water Board of Lemesos is expected to significantly benefit from the development and implementation of high technology related to the collection, processing, electronic archiving and protection of large volumes of data from multiple sources, thus aspiring to obtain a more efficient water supply network management.
